**Farmers School Sportsmanship Award

In order to receive this award the following criteria must be met. The application form and proper documentation should be sent to the NSAA by June 1, 2012.

- 1. Develop a school sportsmanship policy which is prominently posted within the school and if possible printed in the student and activity handbooks (attach a copy of the policy).
- 2. Promote awareness and involvement in sportsmanship and citizenship efforts by accomplishing **three** of the following (provide evidence to verify):
  - a. Attend NCA/NSIAAA Sportsmanship Summit (list names of student and adult participants)
  - b. Receive the NCA/NSIAAA Sportsmanship Award at the NSAA Girls and/or Boys State Basketball Championships (submit a copy of evaluation).
  - c. Utilize the NFHS "Sportsmanship. It's up to you." Materials (provide documentation to illustrate how the material was used).
  - d. Print and announce sportsmanship messages at all spectator activities (provide copy of printed messages and scripts used).
  - e. Publicize/Highlight a public action by a student or coach from your school who exhibited good sportsmanship in the media (provide copy).
  - f. Conduct a school-wide or grade level sportsmanship essay contest submitting the winning essay to the NSAA for possible publication (provide copy of winning essay).
  - g. Conduct another appropriate project (describe the project in detail).
- 3. Promote awareness and involvement in sportsmanship and citizenship efforts by accomplishing **one** of the following (provide evidence to verify):
  - a. Develop a Mentoring/Positive Role Model program for elementary or middle grades (Provide details, who was involved, when and where did the program take place. Provide examples of activities conducted with the elementary/middle grade students).
  - b. Develop and implement a school-wide sportsmanship recognition and awards program (Describe the program and give specific details, examples of awards, and photographs of the awards ceremony).
  - c. Develop a local publicity campaign to produce and present sportsmanship-related public service announcements, local bulletin boards and community service projects (provide photos or copies of articles).
  - d. Conduct a school or community sportsmanship workshop (describe the workshop and give specific details, date, location, examples of topics, guest speakers, participants and provide a copy of the workshop activities or photos).
- 4. Conduct an internal sportsmanship audit or evaluation involving students, staff and community to determine areas of success and specific areas needing improvement (provide details including: date(s), participants, methods of evaluating and results of audit as pertaining to strengths, weaknesses, and action plans to address areas evaluated).

***If a coach from your school was ejected during the 2011-12 school year, you are not eligible for this award.  
Multiple athlete ejections during the 2011-12 school year may eliminate your school from receiving the award.***
